Susan Woolgar: Abstracting The Landscape

This workshop held on Sat. March 11 & Sun. March 12 was a resounding success and left participants wanting more.

Susan guided an eager group of painters through several exercises to help them interpret the landscape in a personal and dynamic manner. She demonstrated a great variety of techniques and tools using acrylic paint that could be applied to any abstract practice.

The **first day** focused on colour theory, mark making and paint application, as well as texturing and experimenting with layers.

The **second day** worked with the elements of design and how to simplify the landscape from a reference photo.

Susan Woolgar is a signature member of the Alberta Society of Artist. After establishing a successful career as a Designer/Illustrator, she left advertising in 1982 to focus on being a Fine Art Painter and Instructor. She continues to explore her artistic expression and love of teaching in a variety of mediums, including acrylic, pastel, mixed media and watercolours. She is represented by several galleries across the country.
